Project “Judges Web”

Last Thursday Microsoft Croatia hosted the presentation of the “Judges Web” project, expected to improve the judicial system in Croatia. As pointed out by one of the authors of this project, Mr Dražen Komarica, “Judges Web” is supported by the Ministry of Justice and several international institutions and Microsoft Croatia has provided help with their expertise and software support. The main goal of this project is to enable entering and browsing of selected documents from court practice. There is work in progress on a web-oriented centralised database, audio-visual communication and videoconferencing. A system of group calendar and conference scheduling is also under construction. The project has been supported by USAID, by the American Embassy in Zagreb, CEELI and some other institutions.

For the time being, the project is in the pilot phase involving a couple of courts from several counties. However, if there is sufficient financial support, it can be expected that this problem area will finally be solved.

Projekt 'Sudačka mreža'

Prošli četvrtak u prostorijama Microsofta Hrvatska predstavljen je projekt »Sudačka mreža« koji bi trebao poboljšati pravosudni sustav u Hrvatskoj. Kako ističe jedan od autora ovog projekta Dražen Komarica, »Sudačku mrežu« podržavaju Ministarstvo pravosuđa i više međunarodnih institucija, a znanjem i softverskom podrškom pomogao je Microsoft. Osnovni je cilj ovog projekta omogućavanje unosa i pretraživanja odabranih dokumenata iz sudske prakse. Radi se na web orijentiranoj centraliziranoj bazi podataka, audiovizualnoj komunikaciji i videokonferencijama, te izradi sustava grupnog kalendara i zakazivanja konferencija. Projekt su pomogli USAID, američko veleposlanstvo u Zagrebu, CEELI te još neke druge ustanove.

Zasad je projekt u pilot fazi u koju su uključeni sudovi s područja nekih županija, no uskoro se može očekivati - ako bude dovoljno financijske podrške - i konačno rješenje za ovu problematiku. (D. T.)
